the age of eighteen (18), unless he/she is legally declared not competent to make
his/her own educational, vocational, and transitional decisions.

Unless the Principal or his/her Designee receives legal documentation declaring a student legally incompetent to make his/her own decisions, the Anderson County School System assumes that a youth is considered to be able to make informed decisions and will afford all rights to the youth upon his/her eighteenth (18th) birthday.

If you believe your child/youth will not be able to make decisions at the age of eighteen (18), please notify the Principal or Director of Special Education (Jason Simpson 859-336-5470) to declare your child/youth incompetent to make his/her own decisions after the age of 18. Documentation will need to be provided regarding legal procedures to declare the youth not emancipated. If you have questions or concerns regarding this legal procedure, please contact your child's special education teacher, School Principal, the Director of Special Education, or your family attorney.
