## ▶ **What is Title I?**

Title I is the largest federal aid program for elementary, middle, and high schools. Through Title I, money is given to school districts around the country based on the number of low-income families in each district. Each district uses its Title I money for extra educational services for children most in need of educational help. The focus of the Title I program is on helping all students meet the same high standards expected of all children.

## **Goals of Title I:**

- Increase academic achievement
- Provide direct instructional support to students.
- Provide professional learning for teachers
- Promote parent education and involvement

### **How may Title I funds be used?**

- ⇒ Instruction
- ⇒ Class size reduction
- ⇒ Summer camps
- ⇒ After-school
- ⇒ Instructional materials and supplies
- ⇒ Additional teachers and paraprofessionals
- ⇒ Parent involvement activities which allow for two way communication
- ⇒ Support homeless youth at the high school
- ⇒ English Learner support
